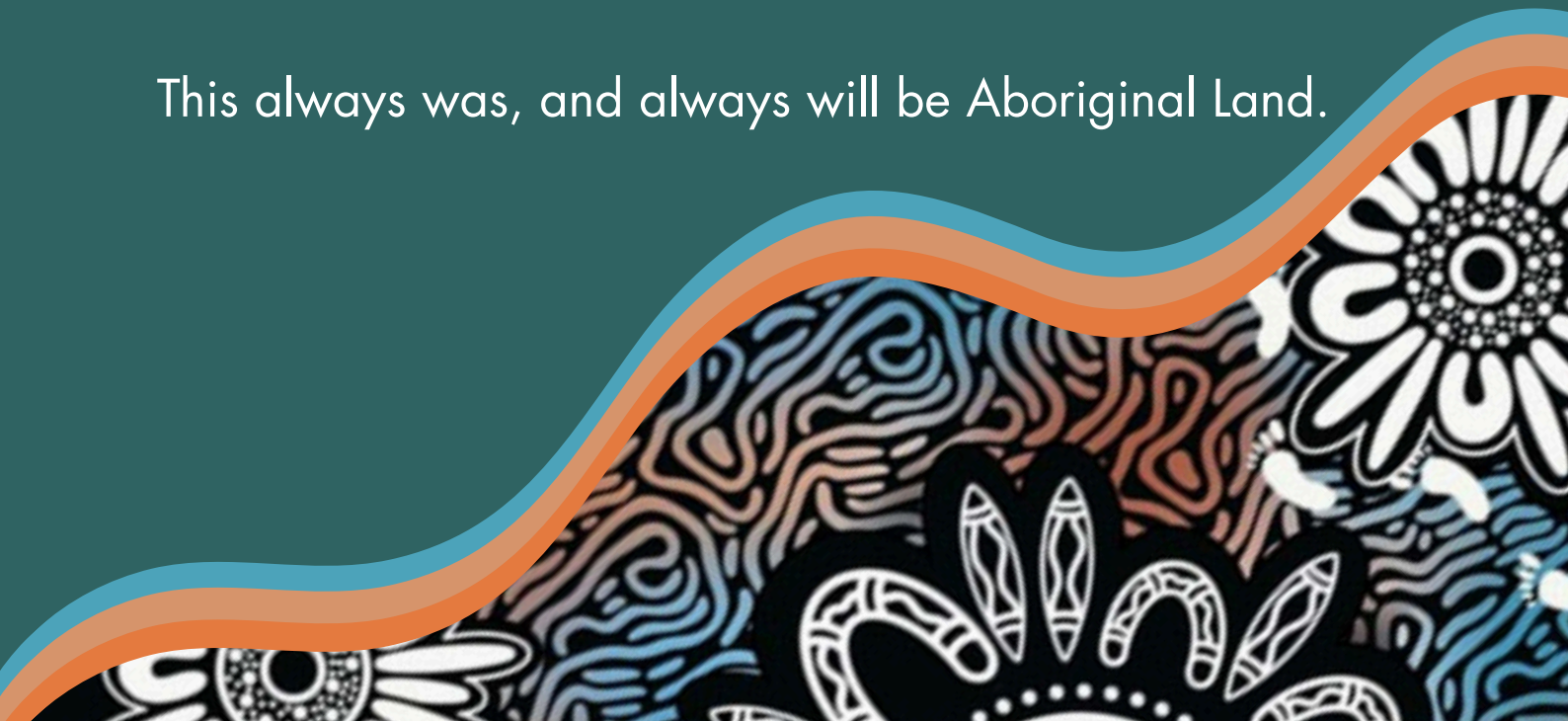
# Acknowledgement of Country

## Vision

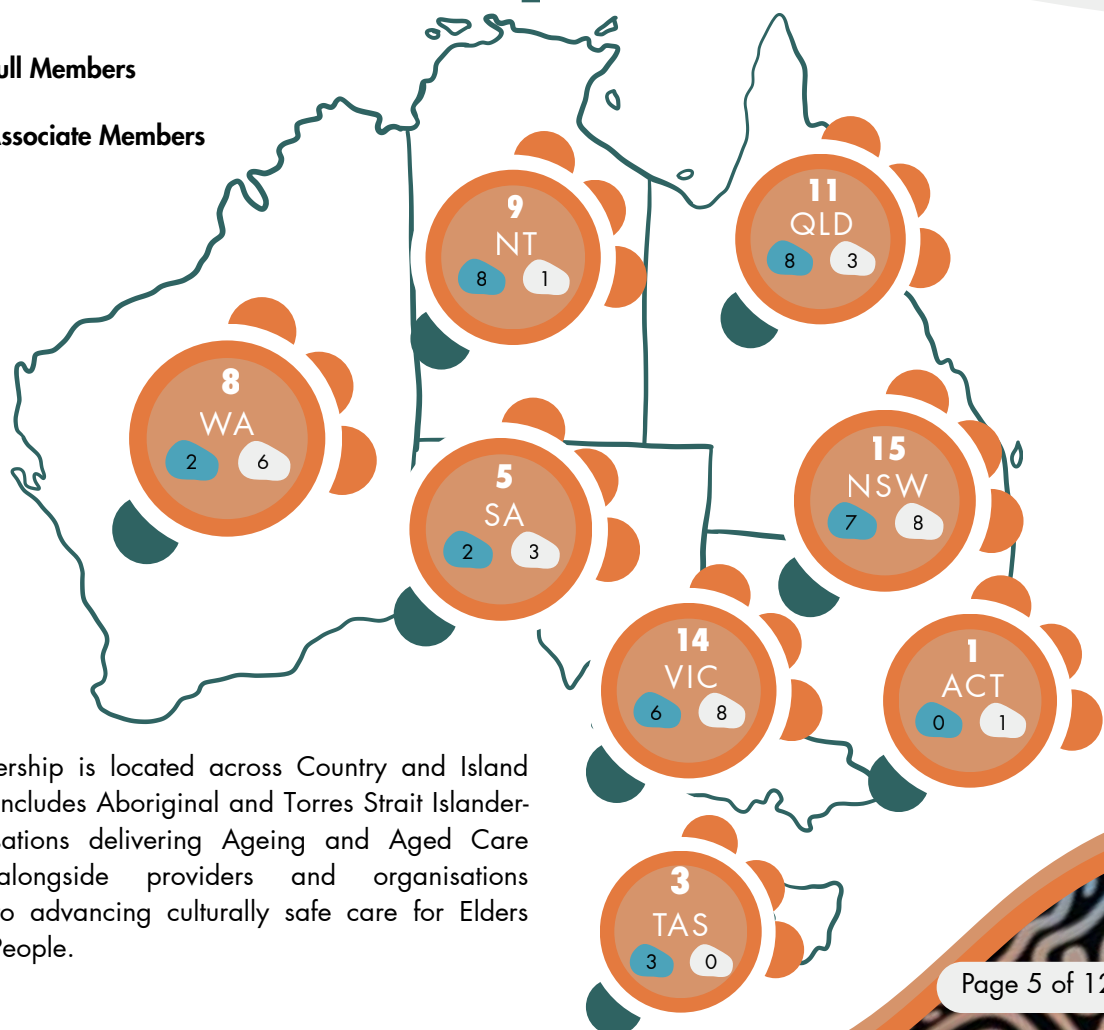
All Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander People are thriving, healthy, strong, with ongoing cultural connections in their older years.

# Terms and Conditions

1. All Partners will be required to enter into a Partnership Agreement with NATSIAACC. Prospective Partners must complete and submit a Partnership Expression of Interest Form. Following acceptance by NATSIAACC, a Partnership Agreement will be provided. Until the Partnership Agreement has been executed by NATSIAACC, the Partnership is not confirmed.
2. The Australian Goods and Services Tax (GST) of 10% is applicable to all goods and services offered in this Partnership Prospectus. As outlined, all prices in this document are exclusive of GST. Once a Partnership Agreement has been executed, NATSIAACC will provide a valid tax invoice to Partners. All monies are payable in Australian Dollars. Electronic Fund Transfer (EFT) are preferred by NATSIAACC and can be arranged.
3. All monies payable must be received in full by the invoice due date. Where payment is not received by this date, the Partnership opportunity may be offered to an alternative organisation.
4. If in the event that a Partner must withdraw from a Partnership, NATSIAACC must be advised in writing at the earliest opportunity. The following cancellation fees will apply:
  - a. If cancelled on or before 31<sup>st</sup> of July 2026, 100% (minus administration fee) of the total partnership amount will be refunded.
  - b. If cancelled on or before the 31<sup>st</sup> of August 2026, 50% (minus administration fee) of the total partnership amount will be refunded.
  - c. If cancelled on or after the 1<sup>st</sup> of September 2026, the total partnership amount will be retained by NATSIAACC.
5. Without the prior consent of NATSIAACC, Partners will not assign, sublet or apportion the whole or any part of their Partnership Package for this conference.
6. If the conference is cancelled by NATSIAACC (including cancellation by any Order issued by the Australian Federal Government or an Australian State Government or Territory), Partners will have the choice to be refunded 100% of the funds received by NATSIAACC in relation to Partnership Agreements associated with this Prospectus and the National Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Ageing and Aged Care Conference. Subject to approval from both parties, funds can be transferred to another opportunity.
